1. Per reference (a), Headquarters Marine Corps (HQMC) established a deadline for installations to achieve an installation-wide, mission-focused fully conformant EMS by 31 December 2007. Per reference (b), HQMC issued supplemental EMS guidance to aid installations in becoming fully conformant. Reference (c) is MCAS Miramar's Self-Declaration of conformance with the Marine Corps EMS.

2. In December 2007, MCAS Miramar self declared conformance to the 18 elements of the Marine Corps EMS. Headquarters Marine Corps received this declaration and validated this conformance through document review and confirmed that the needed requirements have been met, and the identified plans of action are sufficient to track EMS performance.

3. This letter serves as HQMC acknowledgement of MCAS Miramar's EMS conformance and recognition of a job well done. We would like to congratulate your installation employees for meeting the aggressive EMS conformance deadline.
